Wear Blue – pick a day in April where staff and students are encouraged to wear blue to raise awareness.

Request a Sign – put a sign in front of your school, or place a table sign in the front office (CASA can provide you with both!)

Pinwheels for Prevention – create a pinwheel garden outside of your school and invite students to plant their own pinwheel.

Tie Ribbons – raise awareness by tying blue ribbons around the trees near your school (blue tablecloths make great ribbons!)

Donate – put out a donation jar in your front office or make an online donation to CASA of DuPage County at www.dupagecasa.org.

Be Creative – find your own way to raise awareness about abuse and neglect in your school community.
